HOW TO REACH SHIRPUR LOCATION

The above places are well connected from Shirpur through availability

of Maharashtra State Transport Buses, private buses and taxis.

By Air: Nearest Airports- Indore, Aurangabad (200km) and Mumbai (370 km).

By Railway: The nearest prominent railway stations on the main route are Chalisgaon, Jalgaon (MS), Bhusawal (MS), 110 km, Manmad (150 km) (Central Railway) and Amalner, (50) KM, Nandurbar (MS), 85 KM (Western Railway via Surat, Ahmadabad route). Mumbai-Dhule.

By Road: Shirpur is 50 km away from Dhule and 200 km from Indore (MP), Surat (Gujarat), Nasik and Aurangabad. Buses are also available from Jalgoan (110km) and Bhusawal for Shirpur. Buses run between Dhule and Shirpur. Well connected by road through Mumbai-Agra National Highway (NH-3).
